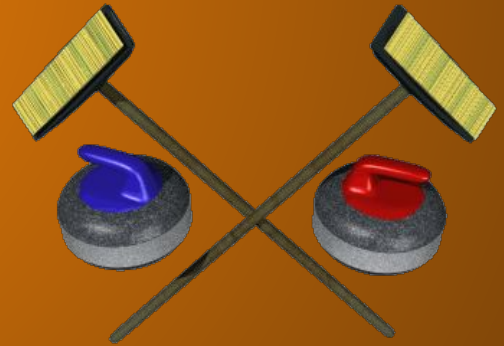

- ❖ The Masters and Grandmasters were hosted and fed by BCBC 12 times!



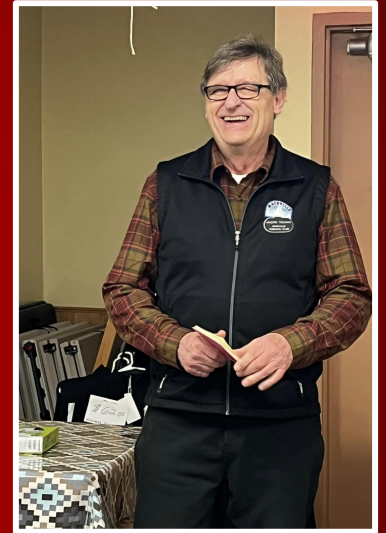

PRACTICE FIRST – Skill Development

- guarding access to a specific region of the house.
- drawing to a precise location behind a guard.
- hitting one stone out of the house.
- hitting two stones out of the house, with a single shooter.
- running a guard into the house for a defensive or offensive tactic.
- softly hitting a stone out of the house while rolling behind a nearby guard.
- placing one stone precisely next to an opponent's stone, to freeze them together.
- rearranging the angles between a cluster of stones in the house.

MASTERS TEAM

This season was also a transition season for the Men's Masters team. BCBC's new five member team has been able to build team chemistry, while making use of the Practice First program.

To our surprise the team participants share similar interests and motives that individual participants do. Because PF drills are prepared with a team ethic in mind, they applied directly to the *rebuilding effort* of the Men's Masters. This experiment in team coaching has rekindled the value of the program for individuals.

In the coming season it would make sense to make this program available to a competitive Women's squad—if there is interest in this.

This season we also introduced a third feature of Practice First that we call a *focused game*. A focused game works by introducing three or four new rules for a four end game. Making it possible for participants to focus narrowly on either offense or defense for a focused game. The challenge to call and make a narrow set of shots builds specific skills and strategic instincts in a team's members.

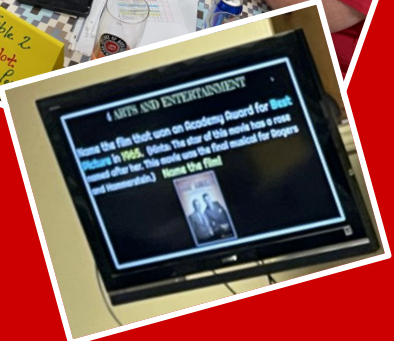

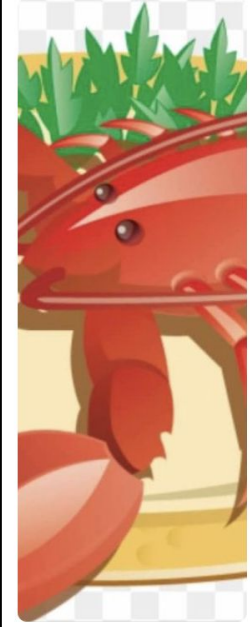
