# Buzz from the Board

#### **On-Ice Heaters**

We asked Sargeant to inspect our on-ice heaters as part of our ongoing club maintenance. One has been red tagged and is now currently inoperable

The Heaters are 20+ years old and therefore we are evaluating the cost of repairing the heaters verses replacing the heaters. The Board is currently going through the process of obtaining quotes on both repair or replacement..

#### **Ice Maintenance**

As part of our ongoing support of our Strategic Plan priority to "Improve our Ice Quality", 7 members of the ice team met with 2 ice makers from Bracebridge to review our ice maintenance procedures and practices. It was a very informative sharing of information and expertise. One of their key learnings was that our ice thermometers are not very accurate, and this has caused us to have too low of an ice temperature. The team is working closely with Scott in slowly raising the ice temperature until we reach a more appropriate level. In addition, the Bracebridge team will be providing new scraping patterns for us to follow. In addition, they have suggested a couple of small tools for us to invest in which we plan to do. We are also attempting to reduce the tracking of dirt from our lounge onto the ice surface. We have installed a BootMaster shoe cleaner and are asking all members to use it before going onto the ice. As well, we are encouraging members to avoid wearing your outside shoes & boots upstairs in the lounge. To assist this effort, we have installed a cubicle in the basement where you can store a pair of 'Club Only' slippers or shoes.

#### Club Maintenance.

We are planning some minor, long overdue renovations. These include a new dishwasher, wall repairs such as the women's washroom and the dehumidifier wall, as well as additional dehumidifier venting and a spruce up of the lounge including painting and the floor replacement. If you would like to volunteer to be part of the team who completes the work, please let one of the Board members know.

#### **Hold the Dates**

We plan to close out the season <u>on March 23</u> with a year end funspiel entitled The Port Cunnington Lodge Rockapalooza. This will be followed by our Closing AGM and Pot Luck <u>on April 6</u>. Stay tuned for more details

# New Branding Initiative



The Ontario Non-Profit Corporations Act ("ONCA") applies to all non-profit entities in Ontario. Under the transition provisions of ONCA, the Club has until the end of October, 2024 to make the necessary changes to our governing documents to bring them into conformity with ONCA. In May of 2021, the members of the Club authorized a change of name of the Club from Baysville Curling Club to Baysville Curling and Bocce Club. Recognizing that as part of the mandated ONCA process we have to file under our proper name and will be incurring legal fees, government fees and other costs, and in order not to duplicate those costs, the name change has not been finalized. This gives us the opportunity to consider this issue further. One suggestion is to take the name Lake of Bays Curling and Bocce Club as it may be seen as better reflecting our actual membership base and be beneficial to membership and sponsorship opportunities.

#### Specifically:

It aligns with the name of the Arena beside the Club and would be consistent with the goal in the Lake of Bays Township Parks, Open Space and Recreation Strategy of investing in the area as a community hub.

It aligns with the name of the library (which itself was rebranded some time ago from Baysville to Lake of Bays – Baysville branch) and the Fire Department.

A significant Baysville businesses is called Lake of Bays Brewery, not the Baysville Brewery. Some may view that Lake of Bays is a stronger 'brand' than Baysville.

Lake of Bays is a larger area than Baysville.

Such new name may assist with improving our profile and importance with Local, Provincial and Federal government entities and the Township staff who work for the Township of Lake of Bays. It may assist in attracting curling and bocce members outside of Baysville, broadening our appeal to all of the Lake of Bays population and surrounding communities.

# **Renovations to the Lounge**



I am pleased to advise that the Board has approved a plan for renovating our lounge. The renovations will involve three key actions:

- 1) removing the carpet and installing vinyl plank flooring on the main level lounge, kitchen and bar.
- 2) enclosing the far end of the lounge to create a storage area for extra tables & chairs; and
- 3) painting of the walls to brighter neutral colours reflecting todays' tastes.

Cathy Hoare & Jim Rotz will be jointly leading the project. Materials and supplies will be purchased by the club - engaging selected sponsors for assistance with regards to discounting of materials and installation – primarily flooring and painting supplies.

Cathy & Jim will be putting together a small volunteer team to run this project. The project team will select colours and materials, assist in preparing the lounge area for the renovations, and performing selected elements of the renovations. We have also approached Beaver Creek Institution in Gravenhurst, requesting their assistance in providing inmate labour for our project – significantly lowering the project cost.

We are targeting the renovations to be completed by May subject to the availability of materials and labour. More details to follow in future newsletters


